HOLZWEG TECHNICAL SHEET H17

LACQUER

Uses Holzweg Floor Lacquer is a clear lacquer that provides a flexible and

extremely hardwearing surface for all interior smooth untreated timber such as floors, stairs, doors, windows, furniture, worktops etc. It is unsuitable for use on cork or rough sawn timber. It has passed tests to be allowed for use

on wooden toys.

Properties Holzweg Floor Lacquer is flexible, water resistant and highly resistant to wear,

even on softwood floors it does not tend to break up or crack. Being non-

plastic based it provides an anti-static surface.

Colour Transparent high gloss. A silky matt finish can be achieved by applying an

additional coat of Holzweg Preserving Wax.

Containers 0.75 litre, 2.5 litre, and 10 litre tins.

Coverage 1 litre is enough for one coat on about 10-12 m² on a smooth wood surface of

average absorbency.

Preparation The surface should be smooth, clean, grease-free, absorbent and dry. For

greater protection it is advisable to pre-treat surfaces with *Holzweg Primer*. Non-absorbent surfaces, for example surfaces that have already been lacquered/varnished, must be thoroughly sanded before the new lacquer is

applied, to ensure a good key.

Application Stir well; apply the lacquer in 3 thin coats, using brush, roller or spray. For the

first coat only, dilute the lacquer with about 20% of *Holzweg Balsamic Turpentine Oil*: once dry, rub this first coat down with 150/220-grit sandpaper, then apply 2 further coats of undiluted lacquer. Each coat must be completely dry before another coat is applied: allow 12 to 24 hours drying time between coats. *Holzweg Preserving Wax* can be applied after the lacquer is dry if a silky matt finish is desired. Use *Holzweg Balsamic Turpentine Oil* to thin the

lacquer and to clean brushes and tools.

Drying times Normally dry enough not to hold dust after 5 hours, ready for sanding after 12

hours, and fully hardened within about 2-3 weeks, depending upon

temperature and relative humidity.

Storage Tightly sealed, cool but frost-free. Storing the tin upside-down will help prevent

a skin forming on the surface - but be sure it is well sealed.

Ingredients Linseed oil, tung oil/colophony mixture heated to 300°C, resin, orange

terpenes, balsamic turpentine oil, silicic acid, aluminium silicate, alcohol,

cobalt lineate.

Safety

This product is inflammable and easily ignited! While working do not smoke and use no naked flame. During and after application keep room well ventilated. Floor Lacquer-soaked cloths should not be left lying around - they could self-ignite. Spread cloths out to dry outdoors, completely unfolded. Keep tins of lacquer sealed and out of the reach of children. Although all the ingredients are biodegradable, left-over Floor Lacquer should not be put down the drain.
